Use the #ntchat hashtag to join the conversation and post your thoughts throughout the week on Twitter.

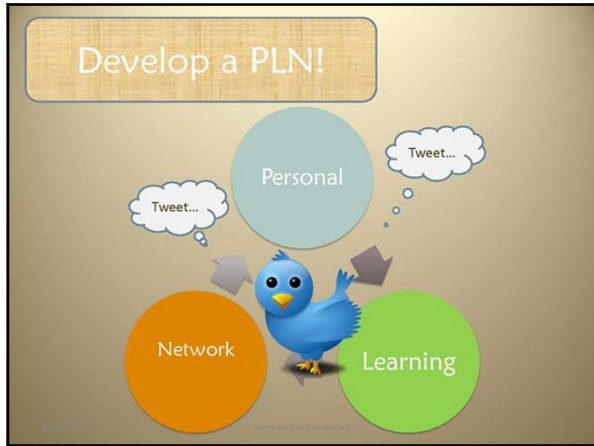

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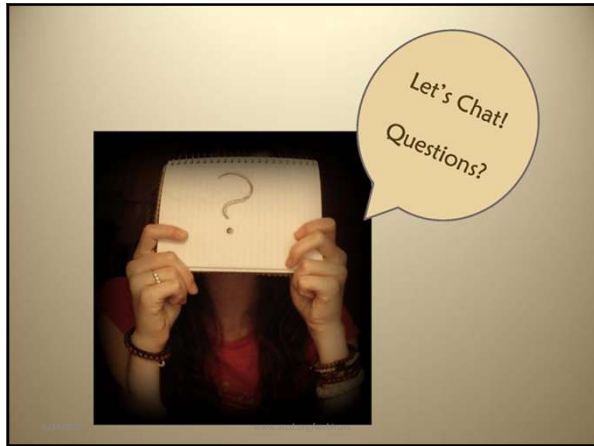
